

CANINE COOLER® INSTRUCTIONS

Please **REMOVE PET FROM ROOM** and take a few minutes to read these simple instructions, and get set up before you

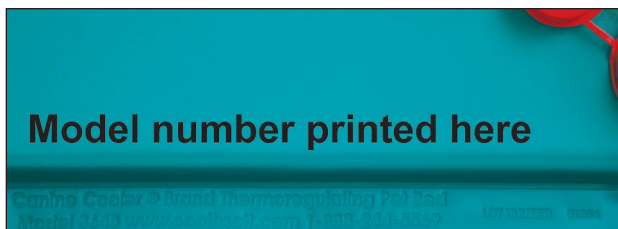
1 WHAT YOU NEED



- Floor space near a sink
- A clean 2-quart pouring container
NOTE: 1 container = 2 quarts = 1/2 gallon
- Towel
- Pen and paper to keep track of water added

2 WHAT YOU DO PREPARE BED

- Open valve and allow bed to inflate for two minutes
- Place towel under “valve corner” of bed
- Locate model number stamped on edge of bed



3 FILLING THE BED SELECT USE & WATER AMOUNT (How will you use this bed?)

A. Use in Home - More cooling, Less mobile

Filling your bed with a selected amount below will make the bed more cool but harder to move.

- Using your model number select, the correct water amount

MODEL 1824: Use 1 1/4 gallon (2 1/2 containers)
MODEL 2436: Use 2 3/4 gallons (5 1/2 containers)
MODEL 3648: Use 5 1/2 gallons (11 containers)

B. Use for Travel - Less cooling, More mobile

Filling your bed with a selected amount below will make the bed less cool but more easy to move.

- Using your model number select, the correct water amount

MODEL 1824: Use 1 gallon (2 containers)
MODEL 2436: Use 2 1/4 gallons (4 1/2 containers)
MODEL 3648: Use 4 1/2 gallons (9 containers)

MEASURE & ADD LUKEWARM WATER

REMEMBER: 1 container = 2 quarts = 1/2 gallon
Lukewarm tap water is fine



- Grasp valve cap lifting bed off floor & slowly pour water
- Use pen & paper to note how much water you have poured
- Pour entire specified amount



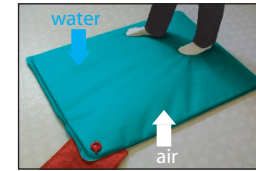
- Check notes to make sure you have added the proper amount of water specified
- Snap valve cap into place

4 MAKE THE BED COOL WORK WATER INTO BED CORE

- Remove shoes and walk all over bed for 1 minute.
- Shuffling and sliding across entire surface works water into bed core and pushes air out toward the surface.



Walk all over



Work water down in & push air up and out

DRIVE AIR OUT TOWARD VALVE

- With feet in a “V”, stand at corner opposite valve
- Shuffle or walk forward pushing air toward valve



- As you near valve, you will see the air bubble created
You will release this air bubble through the valve.

RELEASE ALL AIR THROUGH VALVE

- With feet and bubble in place, grasp valve and cap as shown
- Using a slight twisting motion, partially open valve



- Still holding valve, slowly shuffle feet forward pushing out air
- If water rises into valve, stop shuffling, quickly replace cap. (Losing a little water is o.k.)
- Repeat these air removal steps until you have achieved a good vacuum seal as shown in step 5.

5 WRINKLES EQUAL COOL DOES YOUR BED LOOK LIKE THIS?



A. YES - My bed is wrinkled as shown

Congratulations, your bed is solid, vacuum packed, and wrinkled like the picture.

1. Press your hand into the bed and note memory foam molding action (see picture at bottom of page)
There should be no wavy or sloshing motion.

2. If bed appears correct, gently turn the bed over (using method below) so valve faces floor, out of your pet's reach.

Grasp here by valve → Pull bed over in direction of arrow above.

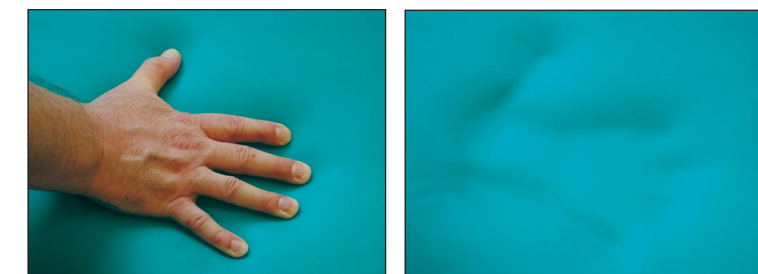
3. NOW LET BED SET UNTIL COOL TO THE TOUCH.

B. NO - My bed is NOT wrinkled as shown

Please try one of the following corrections:

1. If bed is wavy/sloshy, drain out several cups of water until bed is more solid. Reseal and repeat step 4's air removal pass. Repeat if necessary.

2. If bed has large dry looking patches, add more water - about 1/2 quart at a time. Then reseal to and repeat step 4's air removal process.



Correct Memory Foam Action

OFFERING THE CANINE COOLER® TO YOUR PET - DO NOT FORCE YOUR PET ONTO BED

- Pets naturally find the most cool, comfortable place in your home - let them discover the bed.
- Make sure the bed has cooled completely before allowing pet on it.
- Some pets may take a few weeks to discover or use the bed. After 2 weeks if bed is not used try the following: use a Canine Cooler® Cover or bed sheet, place treats on the bed when your pet is not aware, place a shirt you have worn near the edge of the bed for smell association.

Using the bed in the car - Place bed in car or crate just prior to departure. Use a cover or thin sheet to shield it from sun. Sun will heat and discolor the bed. Make bed extra cool by exposing it to air conditioning or a fan before departure. **NEVER LEAVE YOUR DOG IN A PARKED CAR! THIS BED WILL NOT PROTECT YOUR DOG FROM SUCH EXTREME CONDITIONS!**
